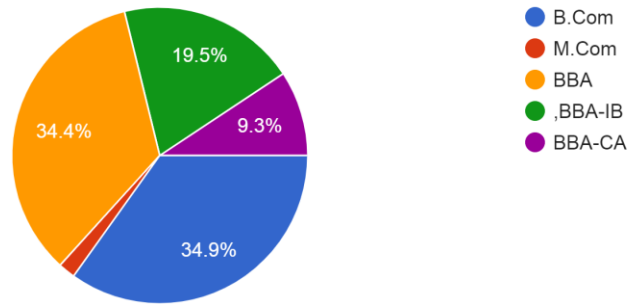

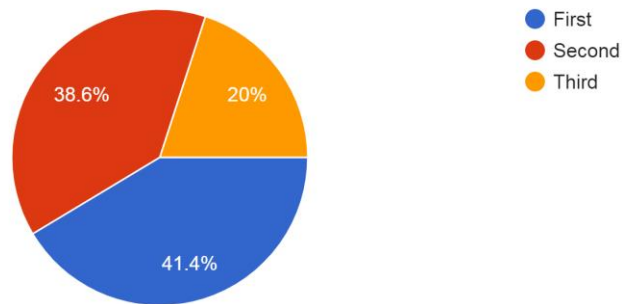

Graph No: 1 Courses in which respondent students had registered.

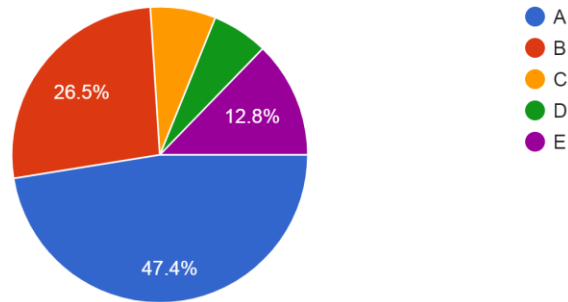

Graph No: 2 Showing Year of the course.

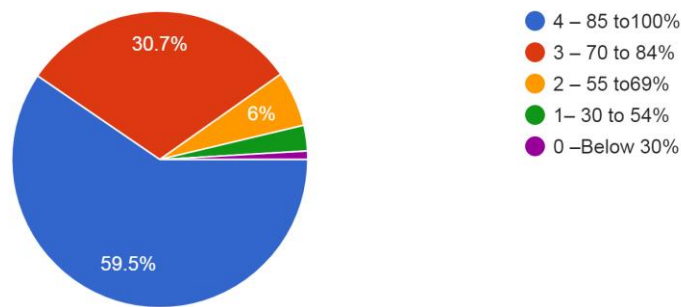

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

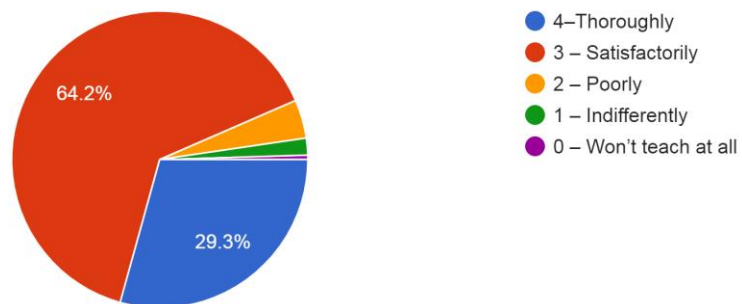

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

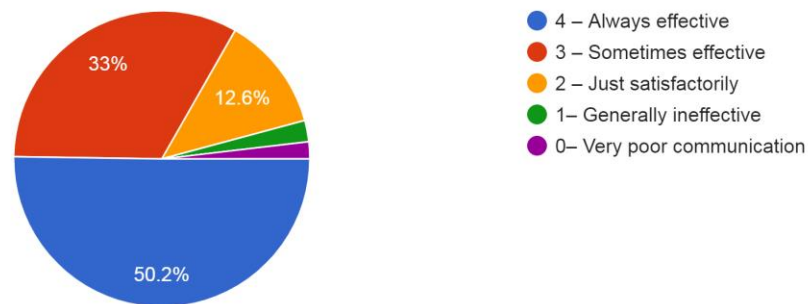

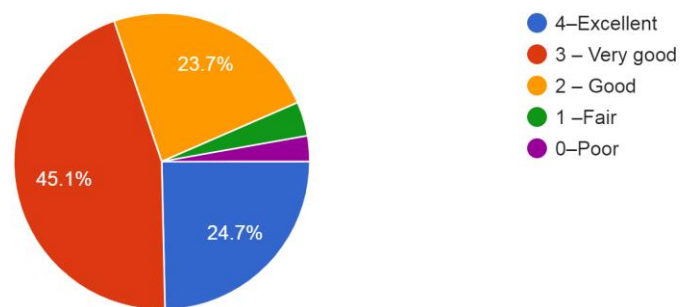

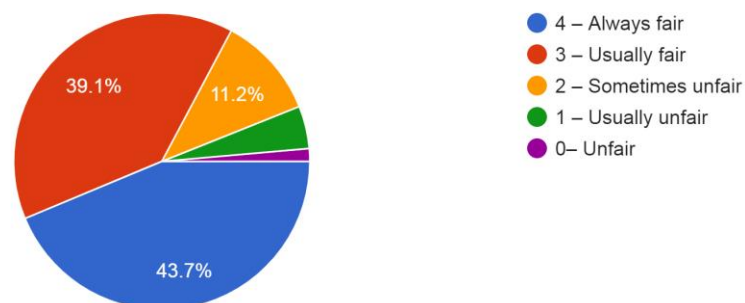

Graph No: 7 Teacher's Approach towards teaching

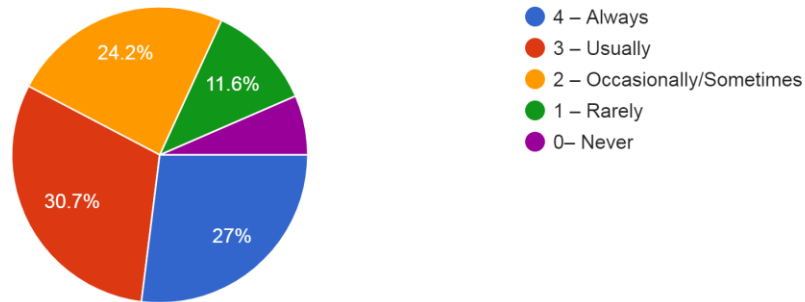

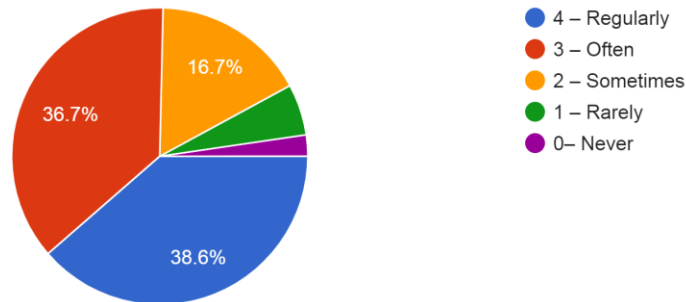
Graph No: 8 Fairness in the Evaluation by the Teachers.

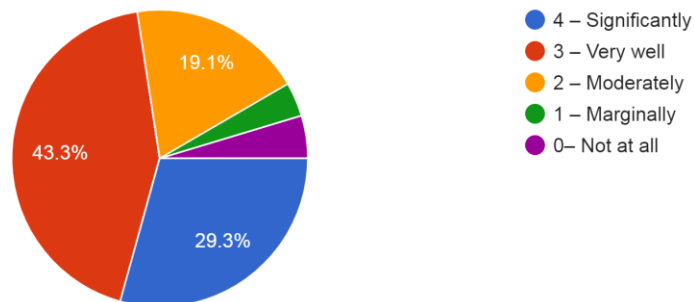
Graph No: 9 Performance in Internal Examination Discussed by the Teachers.

Graph No: 10 Institution takes an active Interest in Internship, Student Exchange.

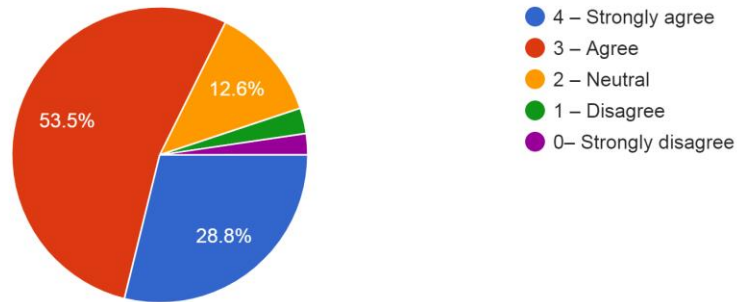

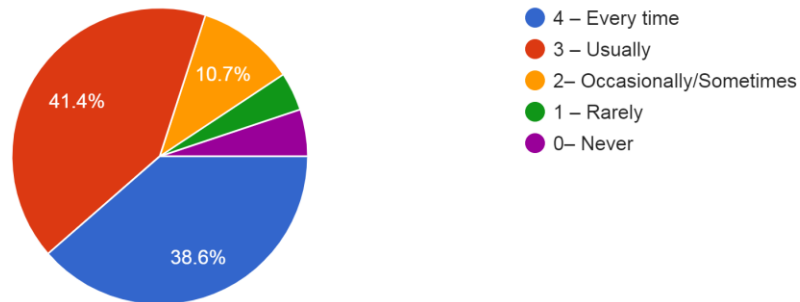

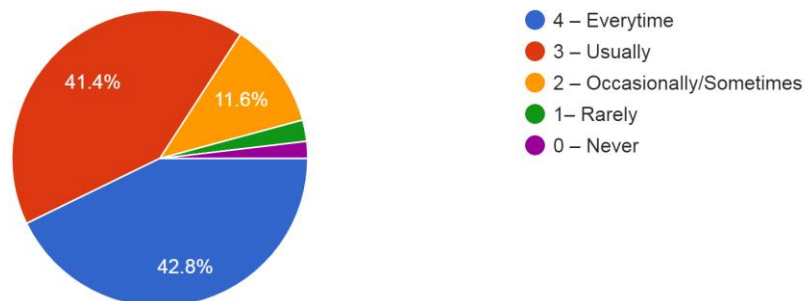

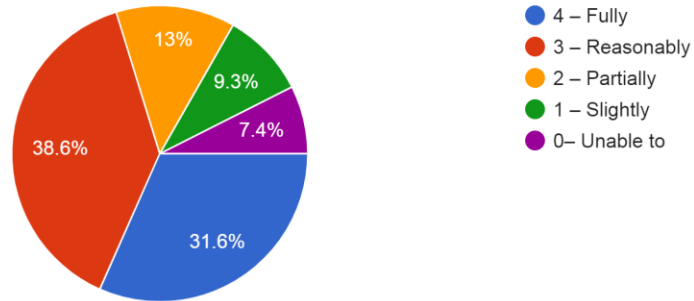

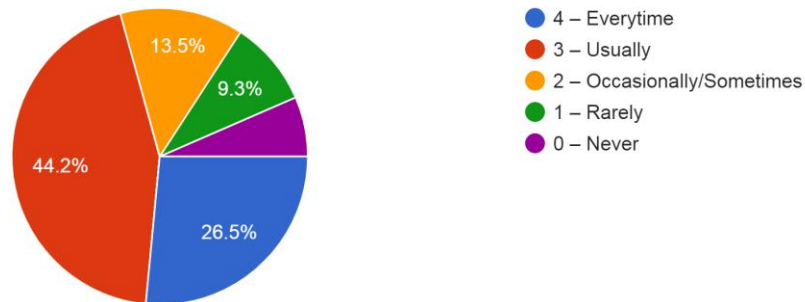

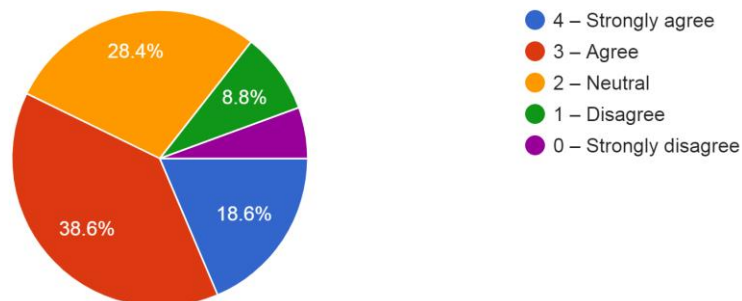

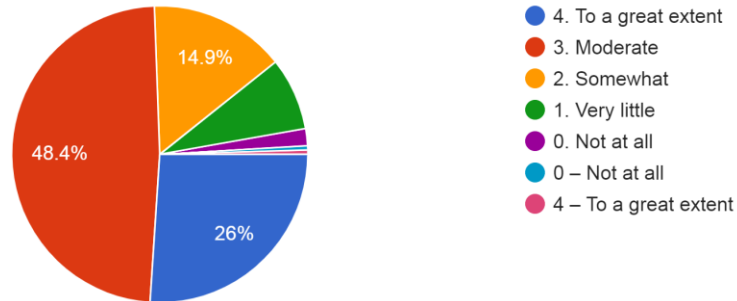

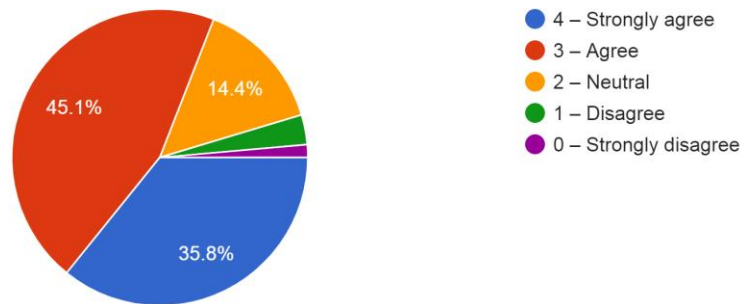

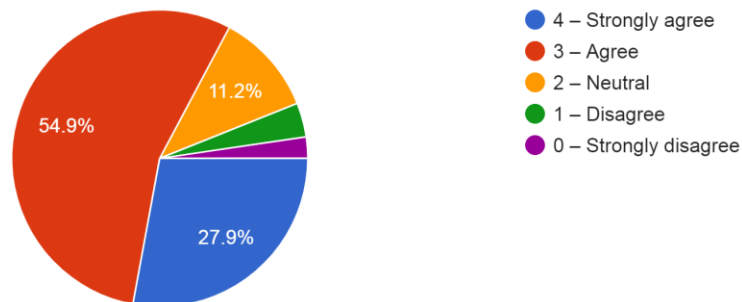

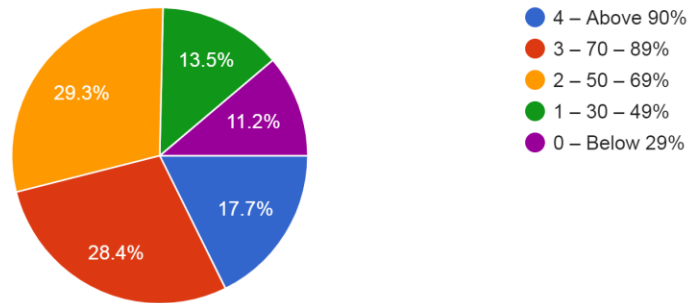

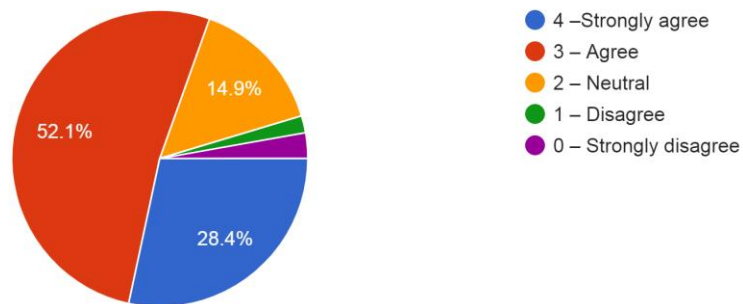
