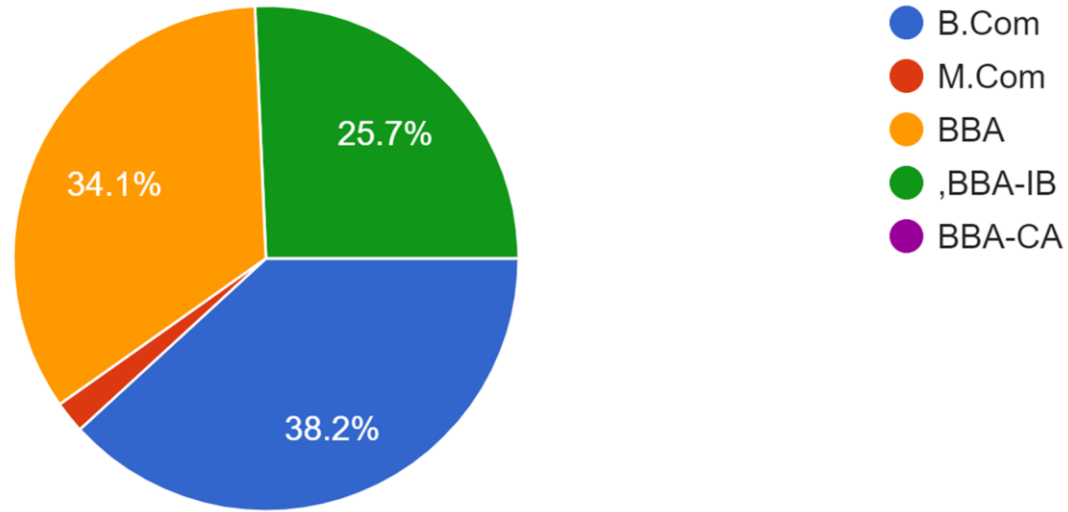


Students Satisfaction Survey (2019-20)
(Total Responses - 393)

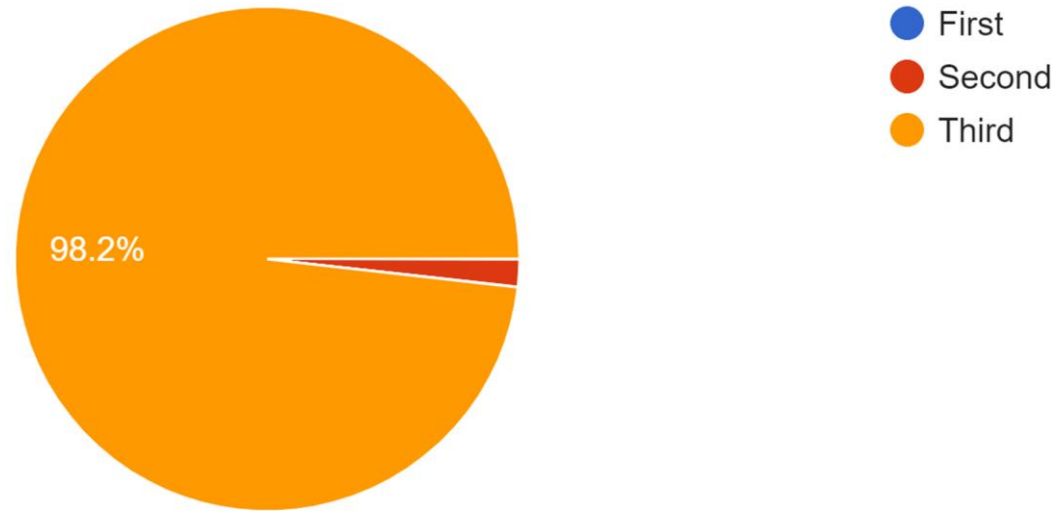
Course

Year of the course :

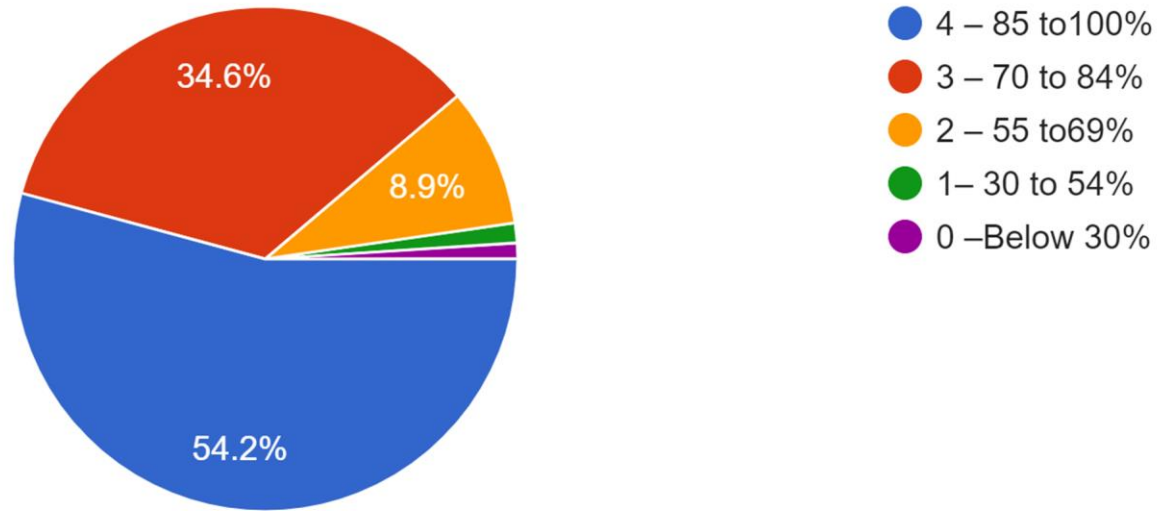

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

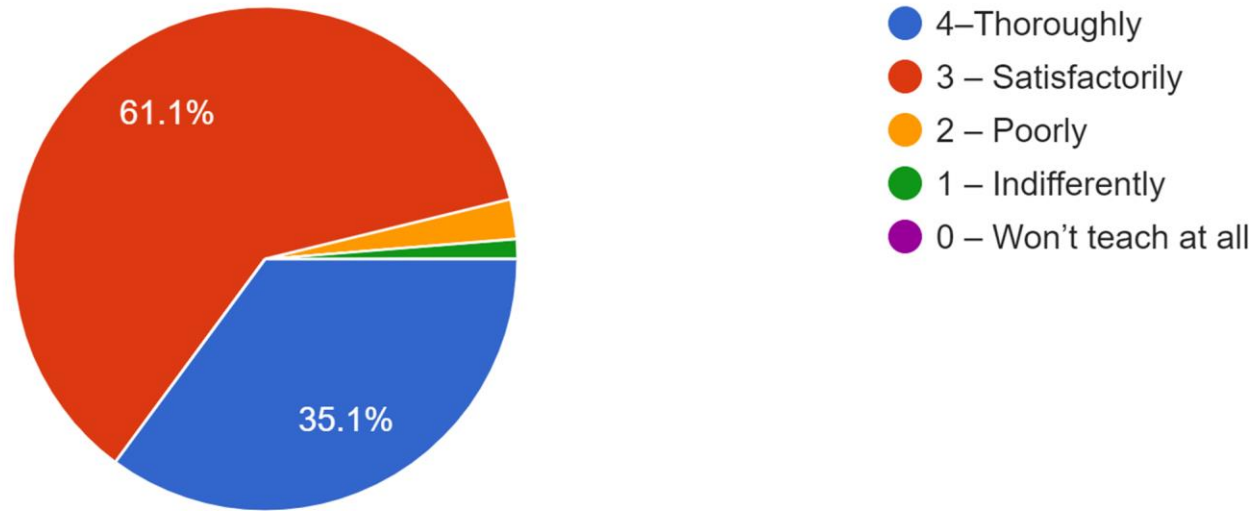

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

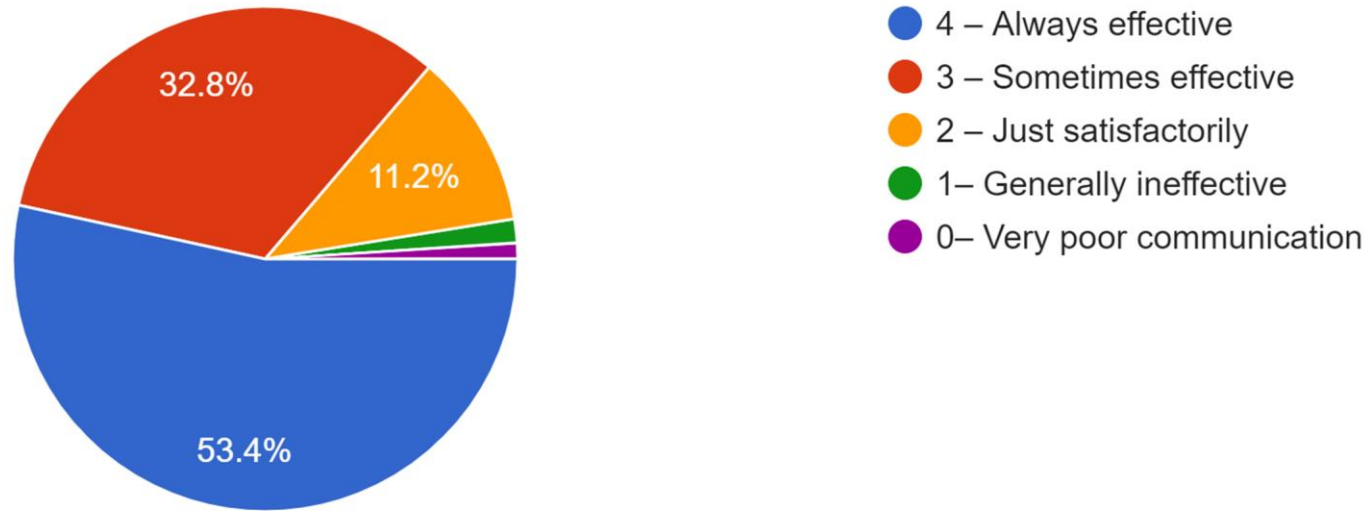

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

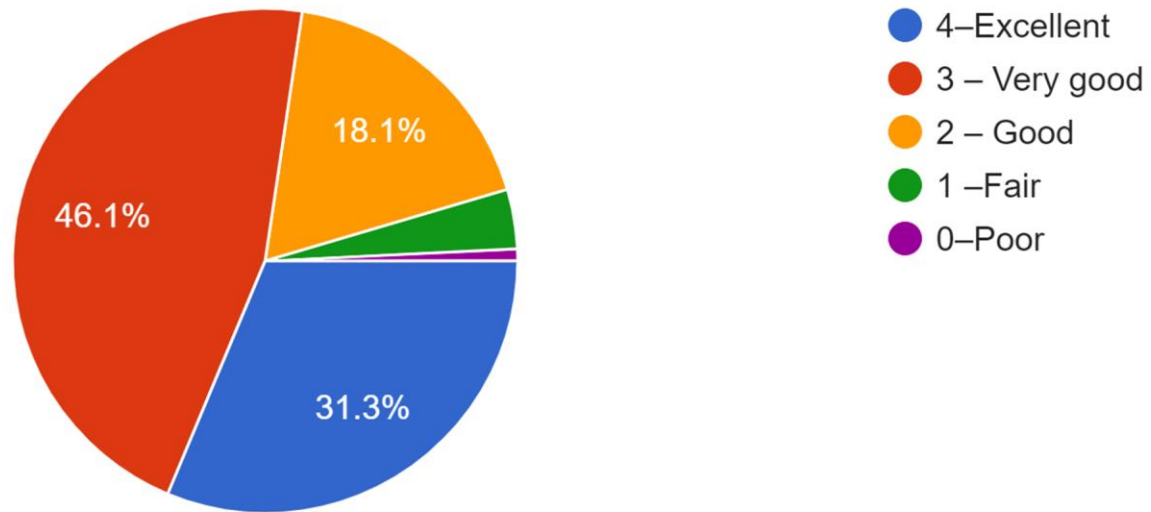

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

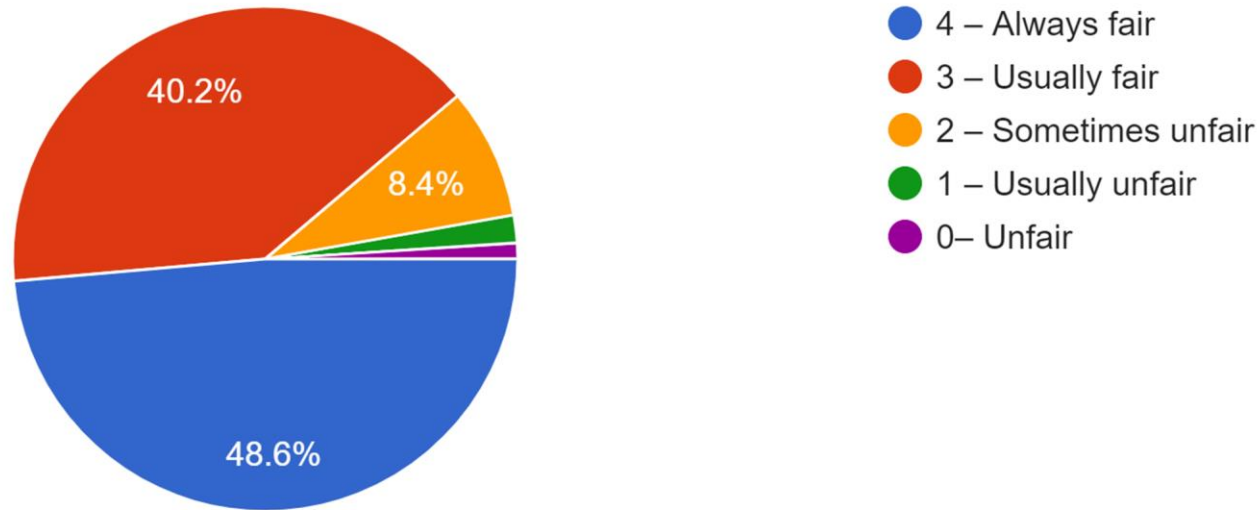

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

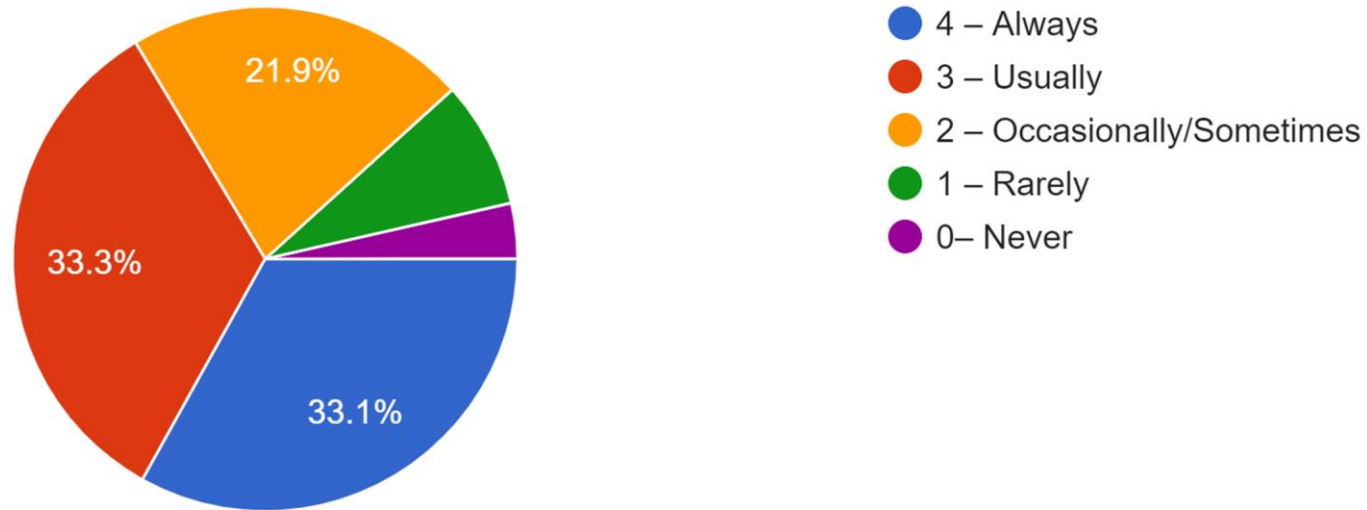

6. Was your performance in internal examination/Practicals discussed with you by the teachers?

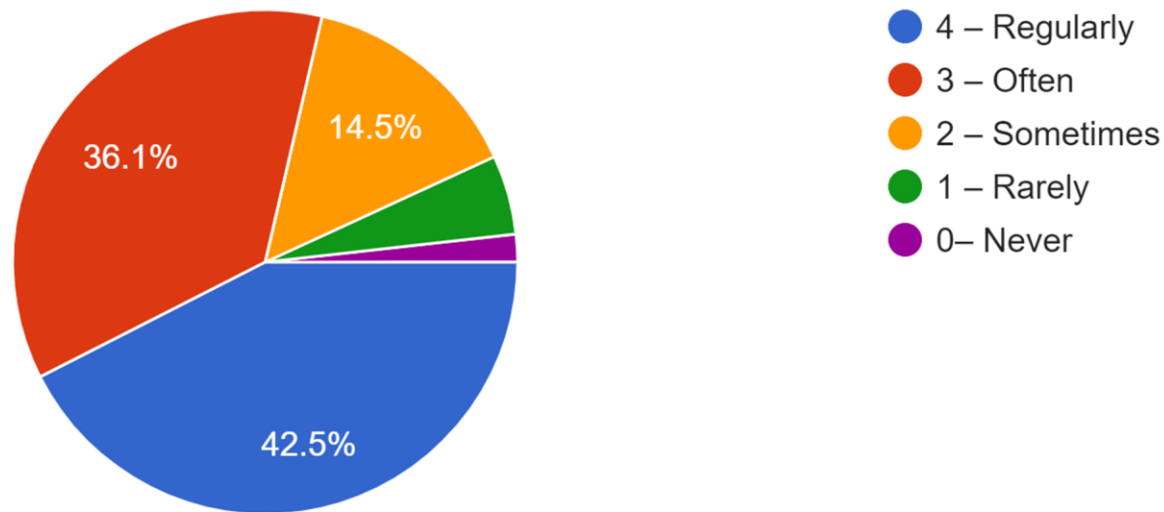

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for the students.

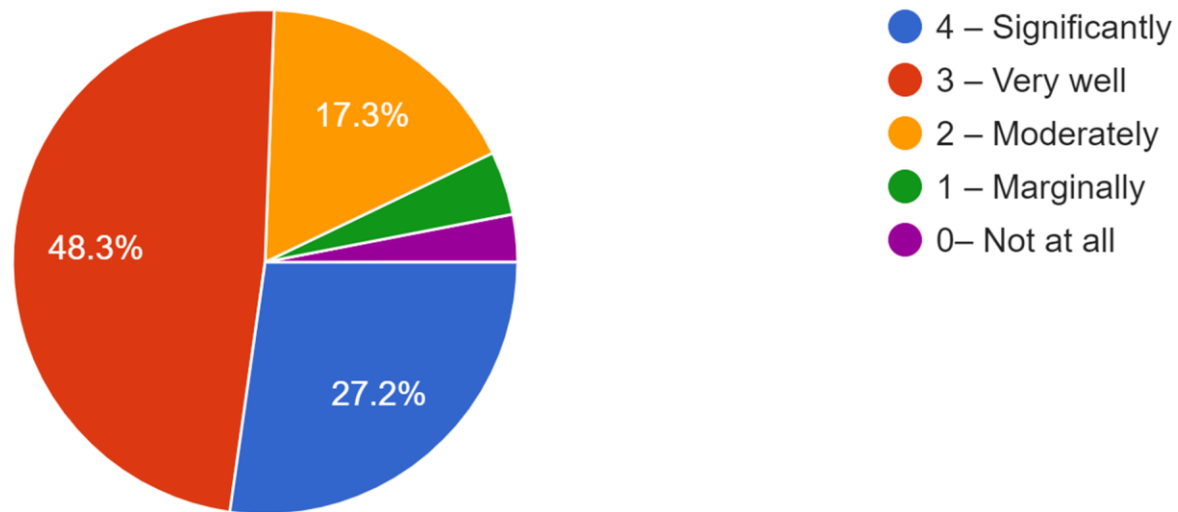

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

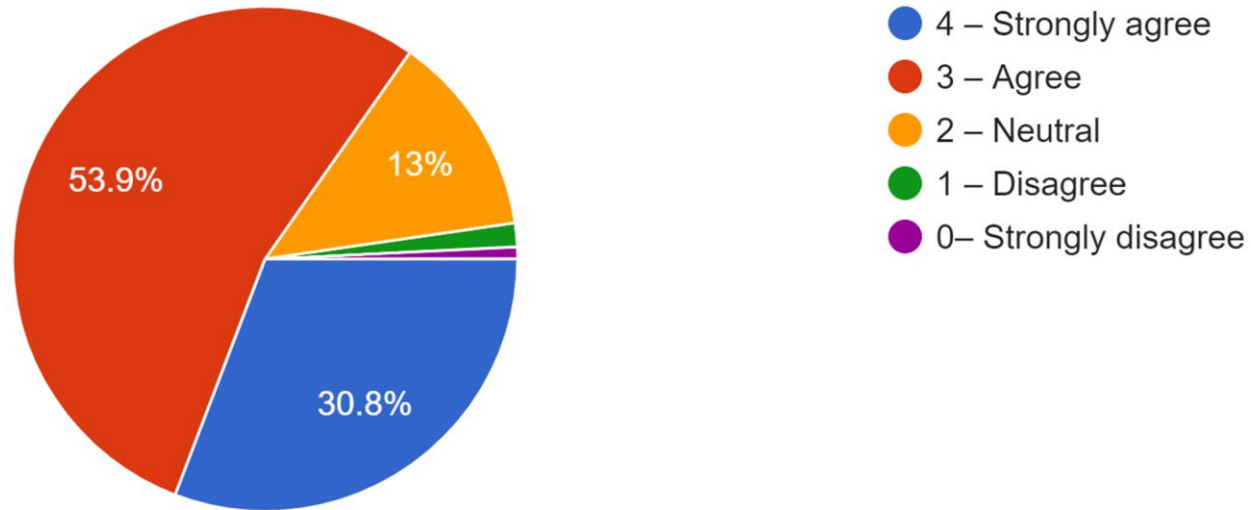

9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

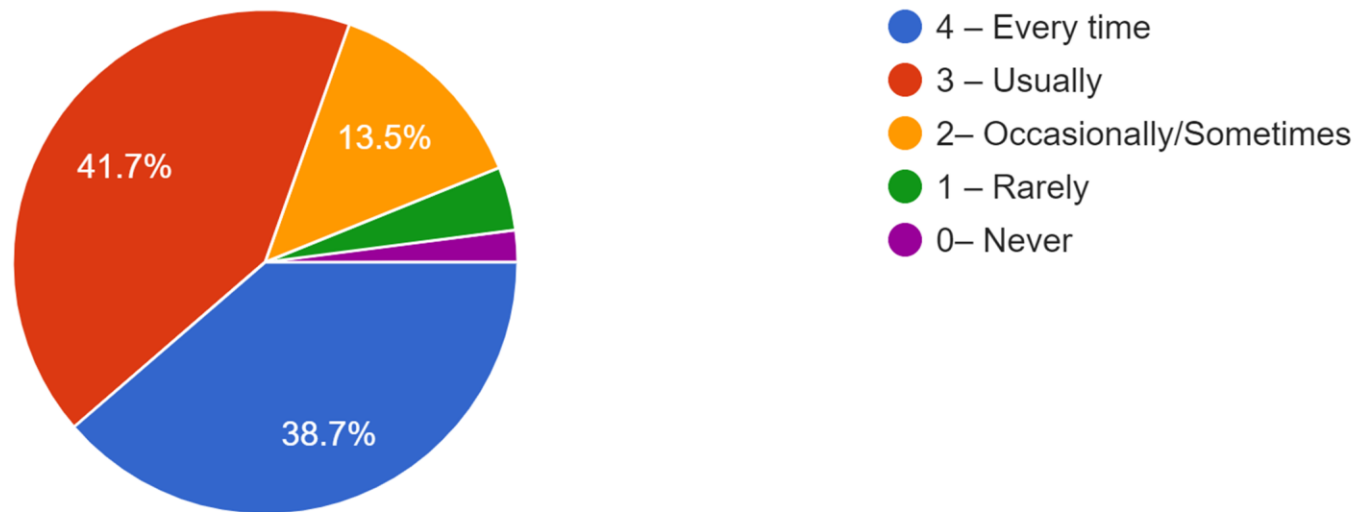

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

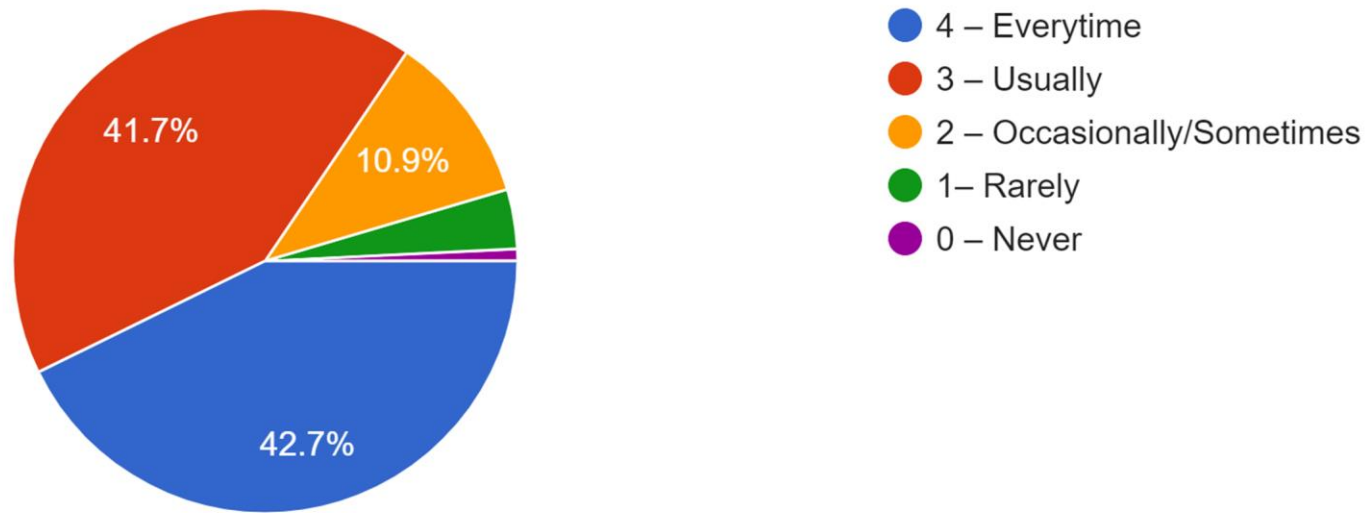

11. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

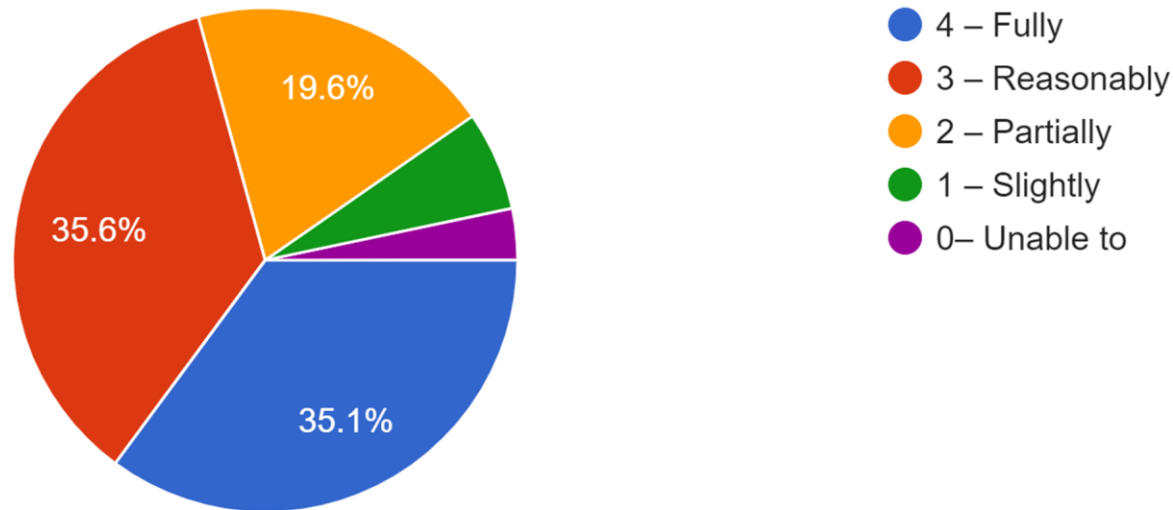

12. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you by providing right kind of opportunities

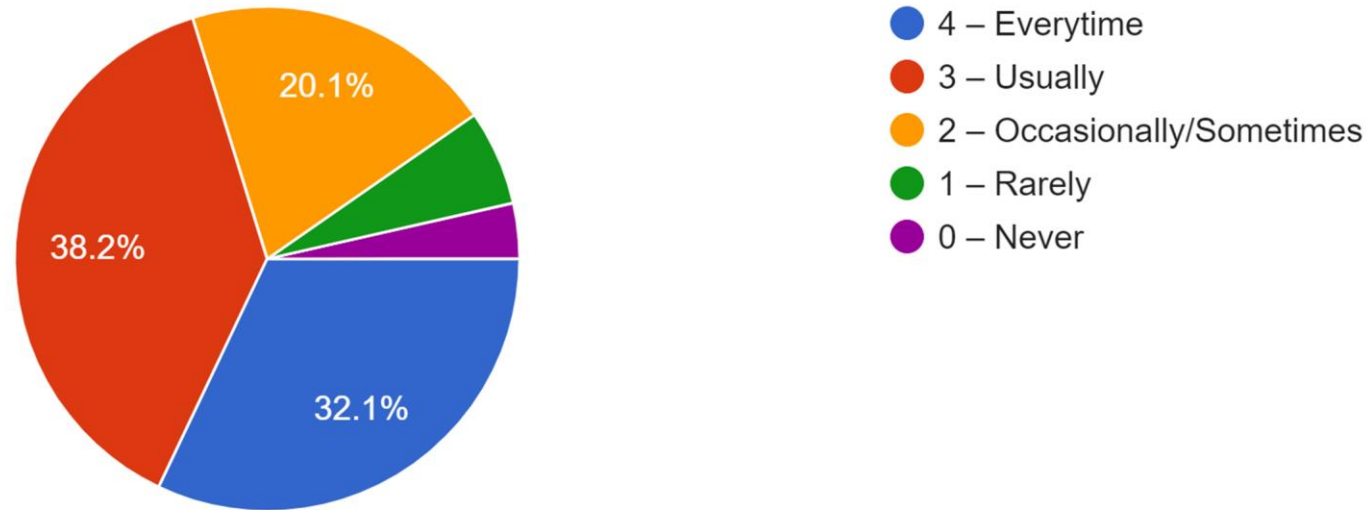

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

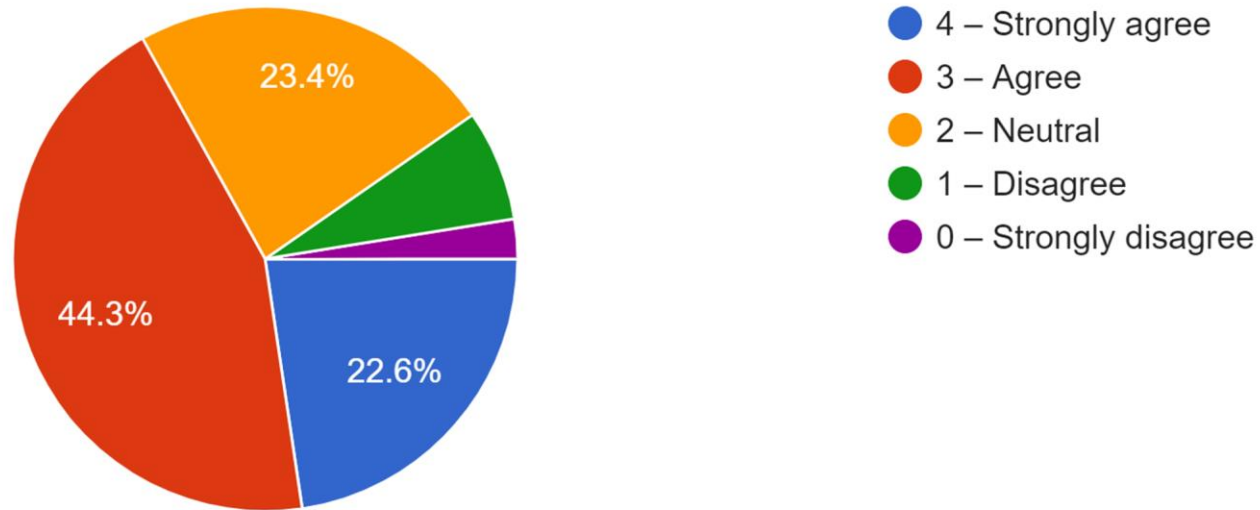

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

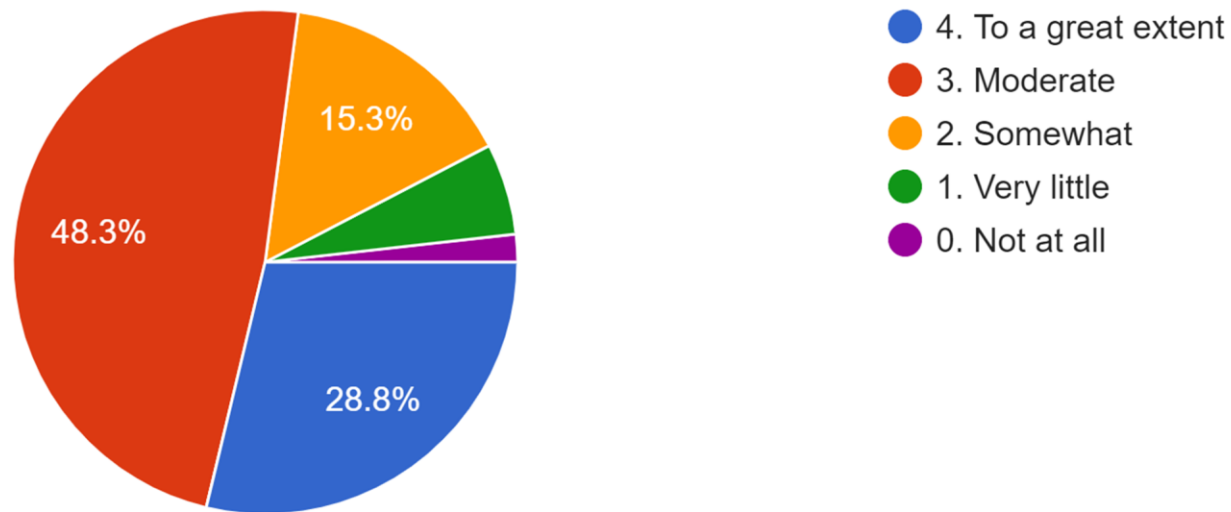

15. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

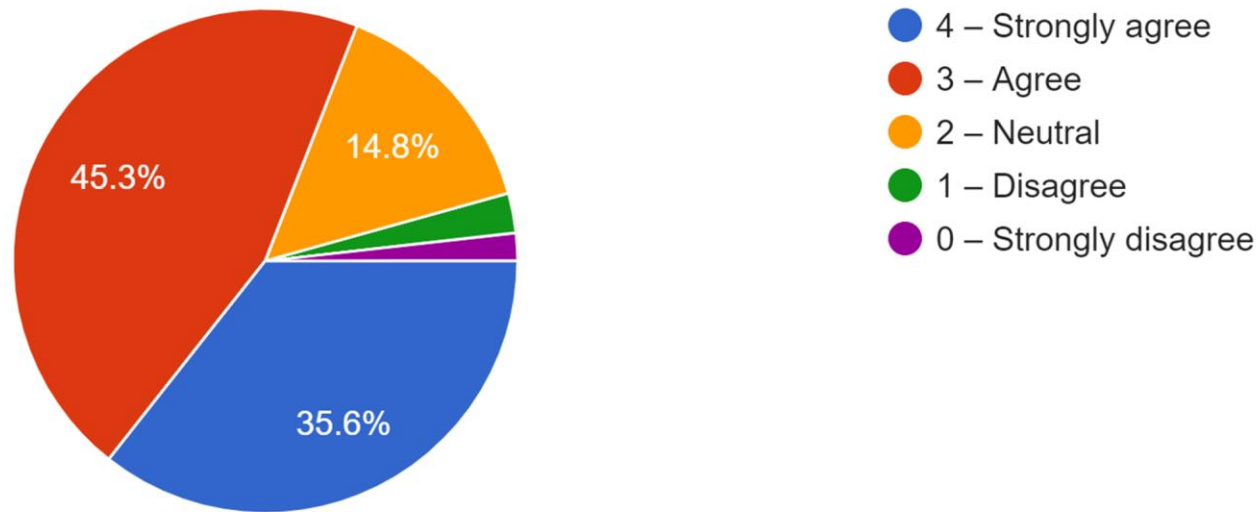

16. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

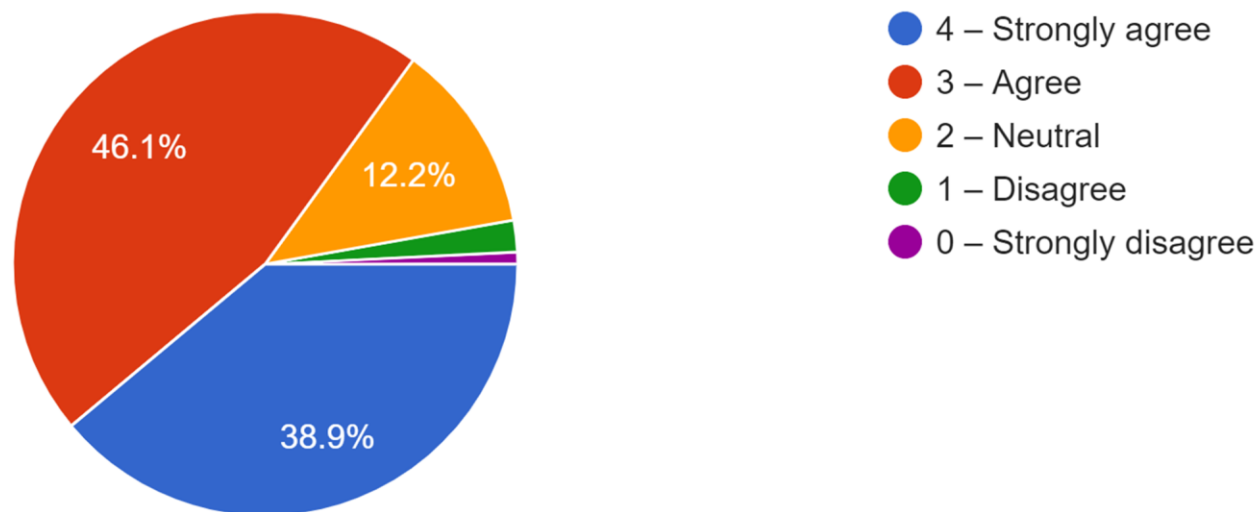

17. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

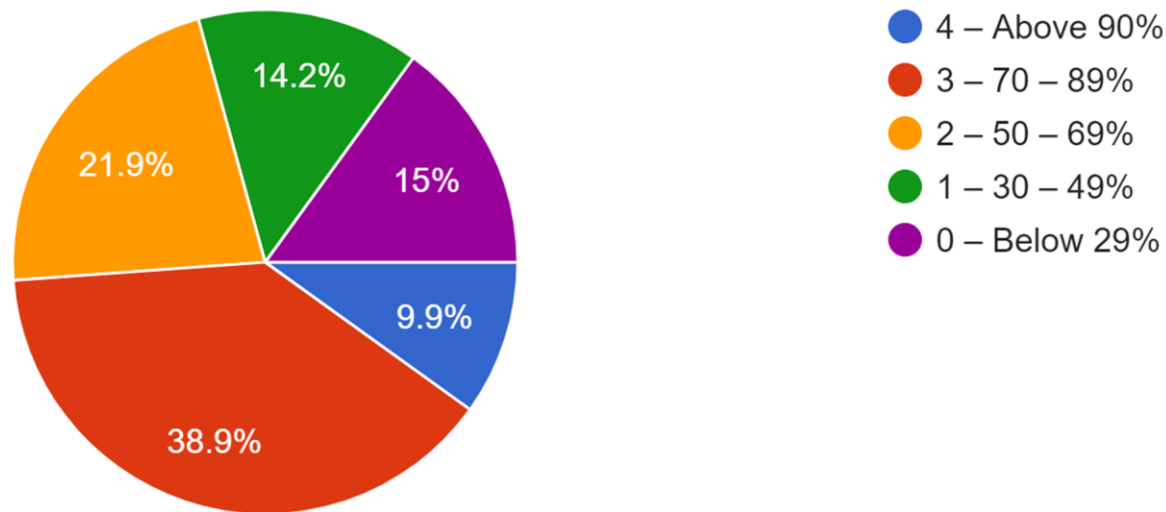

18. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

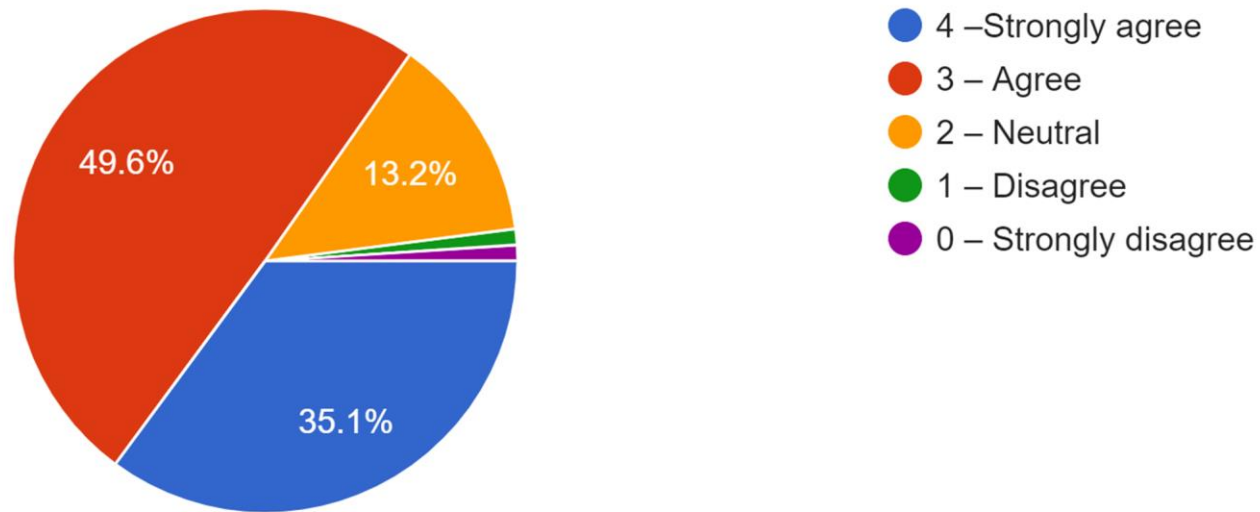

- Use more project based learning, provide real time experience of course.
- More industry visits could be included
- Can add some online courses.
- Focus should be on practical implementation rather that learning theory.
- Need to support students pursuing other professional courses, they are doing these for their increased employability.
- Professors always encouraged us to participate in extra curricular & co-curricular activities.
- Communication in college about notices or instructions needs to improve.
- The office staff need to be more co-operative to the students.
- More social and cultural activities can be promoted.
- Should spread general awareness about facilities provided by college to new students.
- Need to provide internship opportunities to the students.
- Frequently tests should be conducted chapter wise

- More extra curricular activities should be conducted
- Monthly Written exams are necessary
- Need to focus on the field visit, specially for Bcom students.
- CA students should be given some kind of relaxation in terms of Practical Submission
- Need to use of electronic media should be required in teaching process. Concepts should be illustrated properly with examples.
- Accounting subject should be explained more properly as many students do not belong from commerce background.
- Students wants knowledge which will helpful to them for better future. They want Knowledge of Investment, Insurance, research etc.
- Promote sports and yoga for health
