



1. Feedback Form for Students on CURRICULUM (2020-21)

Division: A 584 responses









- > Keep the staff motivated and ensure healthy atmosphere for better productivity.



Interpretation:- Mix responses received from all the students of all the courses.







2. How would you rate the usefulness of curriculum at your workplace/Professional life?








Interpretation:- Majority of the alumni are in the opinion that the present teaching learning process in the college was Very Good & Excellent.

4. How would you rate the significance of the extra curricular and co-curricular activities of the College in overall personality development/shaping your career?






Interpretation:- Majority of the alumni are in the opinion that extra curricular & Co-curricular activities of the college in overall personality development/shaping your career played significant role.

5. How would you rate the following resources/facilities/services available in the college?









Out of 33 Responses majority of the responses were filled out by HR personnels of the respective companies.


Address of the Organization:

Out of 33 Responses, 32 Responses were from Pune City and 1 Response was from a start-up based out of Bangalore.


Qualification of our student employed at your organization: 33 responses



20 Companies Preferred only BBA and BBA -IB Students for their Job Profile


13 Companies Preferred B.Com and M.Com Students for their Job Profile
