Notice Indian Knowledge System Procedure and Instruction for Lectures and Examination

This is to inform all First Year B.Com students that the compulsory Indian Knowledge System (IKS) course will be conducted entirely in online mode through the portal: https://www.bharatvidya.in. All lectures, and the examination will be available on this platform.

Procedure for accessing course:

- 1. Visit Website: Open www.bharatvidya.in in your web browser.
- 2. Login In: Click the "Log In" button in the top-right corner of the homepage. Enter your registered email address and submit. You can log in with a temporary password: "Gcc@2025". Alternatively, an OTP will be sent to your email address. Check your inbox (and spam folder) for the OTP and enter it on the Bharat Vidva login page. Click Submit to log in.
- 3. Accessing course: Go to your dashboard and click on "Bharatiya Knowledge Systems (IKS)" under enrolled courses.
- 4. Lectures: The IKS course comprises 29 lectures, all of which are compulsory. Lectures are presented sequentially, requiring you to complete them one by one.
- 5. Examination: Each section concludes with a mandatory exam (quiz). A minimum score of 40% is required to pass the exam. You are allowed three attempts per quiz. Review the lecture content before attempting the quizzes.
- 6. Certificate & Passing: After completing all 29 lectures and completing the quiz, a course certificate will be generated automatically. Please note: Course certificate is proof of completing the course, securing minimum 40 marks is proof of passing the course. You need both to earn the IKS academic credit.
- 7. Deadline: The last date for completing the course and examination is 20th Sept. 2025. Students failed to meet the deadline will be failed in the course.
