MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU) is made and entered into by and between the ILS Law College, Chiplunkar Road (Law College Road), Pune, 411 004 and MES Garware College of Commerce (Autonomous), Karve Road, Pune, 411 004.



Whereas Indian Law Society, a public charitable trust, registered under the Societies Registration Act, was established in 1923. The society was established with the sole purpose of imparting legal education. Indian Law Society established ILS Law College in 1924, with a view to provide facilities for the study of law. ILS Law College affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University is a premier legal institution imparting quality legal education. The College has strived to impart socially relevant and professionally desired legal education since its inception. Apart from Classroom teaching, the College conducts diverse activities which are multidisciplinary in nature

enabling a student to comprehend the law from multiple perspectives through its Cells and Centers like Centre for Technology, Intellectual Property and Media, Centre for Public Law, Women's Studies Centre etc.

**And whereas** Maharashtra Education Society (MES) established in 1860 and registered under Society's Registration Act on November 19, 1887 and registered under the Bombay Public Trusts Act on December 15, 1952. Its office is situated in Pune. It has been contributing to the field of education by providing education from kindergarten to post-graduation. MES Garware College of Commerce (Autonomous), is a premier commerce college in Pune, established by MES in 1967. It is a leading single faculty Commerce College affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University. The institution offers several programmes like B. Com., M.Com, BBA, BBA (IB), BBA (CA) & BBA (Design & Innovation). It has a recognized Ph. D research centre. It conducts various research activities, and has industrial and institutional tie-ups and collaborations. Various optional and special courses in Commerce and Business Administration curricula are taught in the College. Apart from classroom teaching, the College conducts diverse co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the benefit of the students.

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this MoU is to outline the terms and conditions of collaboration between the **ILS Law College, Pune** hereinafter referred to as '**ILS Pune**' and **MES Garware College of Commerce (Autonomous), Pune** hereinafter referred to as '**MES GCC**'.

### **Deliverables from ILS Law College, Pune (ILS Pune) & MES Garware College of Commerce (Autonomous), Pune (MES GCC)**

1. ILS Pune will provide a Campus tour to the selected students (up to 25 at a time) of MES GCC visiting the institution.
2. ILS Pune will provide an opportunity to the selected students (up to 25 at a time) of MES GCC to observe an advocacy skills competition in mock courtrooms, organized by ILS Pune.



3. ILS Pune will arrange a guidance session by a faculty member, focusing on 'Career in Law' to the students of MES GCC visiting the institution.
4. ILS Pune will provide the permission to the selected students of MES GCC to use their library on payment basis & as per the rules of ILS library.
5. MES GCC will provide the permission to the selected students of ILS to use their library on payment basis & as per the rules of GCC library.
6. MES GCC will arrange guidance session for ILS students in areas related to Business Economics, Management studies etc.
7. Both colleges intend to conduct collaborative activities like industrial visits, workshops, symposia, guest lecturers in courses like IPR, Economics, Business laws, Consumer Protection, Human resources, Organization behavior etc. for the students & faculty.

### Terms and Conditions

1. This MOU is valid from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2025 till 1<sup>st</sup> February 2027.
2. This MOU is governed by the constitution, rules, and regulations of Indian Law Society & MES.
3. Both parties agree to fulfill the deliverables outlined above for a mutually beneficial partnership.
4. Any modifications to this MoU must be agreed upon in writing by both parties.

**About MEDC:**

MEDC is a professionally managed non-profit organization established by Late Dr. Dhananjay Rao Gadgil, an eminent Economist and former Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission, Govt. of India. MEDC is an economic think tank which assists the State & Central government and Urban Local Bodies in economic and social development.

MEDC is the only organization of its type, not only in Maharashtra but also in India, both in the nature of its membership and its activities. It has been focusing all its attention on Maharashtra in particular and India in general and with its sustained efforts; it has been trying to achieve a rapid and balanced economic and industrial development of our State. The Post Graduate (PG) programme, Masters in Commerce (M.Com.) and Doctoral Studies Ph. D. (Under Faculty of Commerce & Management) facilities are also offered on the Campus.

For internationalizing of education, the College has taken initiatives to collaborate with international institutions like James Cook University, Singapore and University of Hull, UK.

The two organizations have decided to conjoin their strength for the benefits of both and for the economic benefit of people at large. The mutual understanding reached between the two in writing is as follows:

### MODE OF COLLABORATION:

#### Both parties shall offer the followings:

Names of the Interns will be decided by MEDC, and Internships & Placement Department of MES GCC will ensure that interested candidates are selected for Internship.

Duration of the internship will be decided by the Internship & Placement Department of MES GCC in consultation with MEDC.

- This is a performance-based relationship MOU, satisfactory performance of minimum standards is the key criteria, and quality of research is vital for the continuation of the relationship amongst the parties hereto.
- Any amendment to this MOU shall be carried out in writing duly authenticated and executed by both the parties.
- This MOU will be affected for one year from the date of execution and thereafter extended from year to year with mutual consent.
- The Annual membership fees of INR 20,000/- plus one-time admission fee of INR 5,000/- plus 18% GST = INR 29500/- will be paid by MES Garware College and MEDC will raise the invoice for the same
- This MOU may be terminated either by mutual consent or by any one of the parties giving a notice of one month to another party specifically disclosing the intention and reason/s, to withdraw from the MOU.
- The parties concerned shall refer to any dispute or difference arising out of this MOU first to each other for mutual settlement and agreement. If such mutual settlement is not possible then it shall be referred to an eligible arbitrator and the provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act shall

apply to the such arbitration proceeding. The decision of this arbitrator would be binding on all the parties.

- In case of termination of MoU, the students who are placed for internship with MEDC should be allowed to complete their term.

#### **MES GCC will enable/facilitate the following- depending on offerings:**

- MES GCC, being a Commerce College, the faculty will mainly conduct joint research in Commerce, Management and Economics along with MEDC as per the educational requirement that could be aligned with the research interests of MEDC.
- MESGCC will assign small research projects to its students that would form the large project assigned by MEDC. These projects will be modelled as per Department of Research, Innovation and Consultancy in line with the curriculum requirements.
- The Internships & Placement Department will circulate information about internship opportunity in MEDC for the students
- The Internships & Placement Department of MES GCC will arrange placement drive whenever there will be vacancy in MEDC
- The Internships & Placement Department of MES GCC will make the arrangements of presentation of MEDC for the Internship Programme.
- MES GCC can publish their advertisement in MEDC Economic Digest on a discounted rate. (Decided at the time of advertisement)

#### **MEDC will enable/facilitate the following- depending on offerings:**

- MEDC Monthly Economic Digest will be dispatched every month
- Weekly Economic Review will be shared on registered email ID of MES GCC
- MEDC will share about the events/programmes through mail.
- Help to develop linkage with industrial sectors to organize training for the employees of the respective companies / NGOs etc.
- MEDC will admit selected students of the MES GCC as research interns as per Department of Research, Innovation and Consultancy (DRIC) of MES GCC preference. MEDC will admit these

students as per their academic schedule with express permission from the Department of Research, Innovations and Consultancy of MES GCC. These internships will be available to MES GCC students all year round or even after they have completed the course.

- Administration and Operations Internship opportunity will be provided by MEDC.
- Suitable candidates will be placed in the MEDC or will be provided with an internship certificate and stipend. Recommendation letter will be provided as per request.
- Creatives and advertisements of Internship Opportunity will be provided by MEDC
- At the placement drive, MEDC will come to the College for conducting interview.
- One day Volunteer opportunities will be provided to MES GCC students at the time of MEDC programmes/Events. (Non-Monetary)
- Project base Volunteer opportunities will be provided to MES GCC students at the time of MEDC programmes/Events and research. (Non-Monetary)
- Participation in MEDC Programmes/Events for Principal, Trustee, Professors and students without any cost. (8 to 10 Faculty Members and 25 to 30 students)
- Professors and Students can submit their article for MEDC Economic Digest and can be published if it is approved by the President & Editorial Team.
- MEDC Board room and meeting room can be used on discounted rate.

### Implementation

- This MoU is non-binding and any binding obligations will be in any definitive agreement, which Parties may sign as a result of discussions under this MoU.
- Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make either party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.
- All activities of co-operation implemented under the terms of this MoU shall be mutually agreed upon in writing, including the roles & responsibilities and budget, as the need may arise.
- Each of the parties shall be fully responsible financially for the activities carried out under its direction or by its staff, except as otherwise agreed by the parties.
- The parties will designate one representative each who will develop and coordinate specific programs or activities between them.

- The relationship of the Parties under this MoU shall be non-exclusive and both Parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, when entering into a particular agreement, the Parties may agree to limit each Party's right to collaborate with others on that subject.

### **Intellectual Property**

The Parties acknowledge that nothing in this MoU and NDA shall affect ownership of any intellectual property rights of the other party.

### **Confidentiality**

During the currency of the MoU, each Party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other Party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.

### **Duration & Renewal**

- This MoU will become effective immediately after signature by the representatives of the Parties. It will be initially valid for a period of One year from the date of execution of this MoU.
- The MoU will be automatically renewed for further periods of one year after paying MEDC Annual Membership Fees as per actual in that year.
- The MoU is terminated by either party on prior written notice of 30 days to other party.

### **Amendment**

This MoU may be amended by a written agreement signed by representatives of the parties. In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaborative activities in either country, the parties agree to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution. Should any disagreement arise out of the application, interpretation or implementation of this Agreement, the Parties shall endeavour to exercise best efforts to negotiate their differences.





2) Coordinators. Each party shall designate a person to serve as coordinator to oversee the implementation of this MOU. The coordinators, working with other appropriate administrators of the respective parties, shall have the following responsibilities:

- b) To act as principal contacts for individual and group activities and to plan and coordinate activities within their institutions as well as with the other party;

  - ii) The coordinator for Vietnam Aviation Academy will be Dr. Trà Nguyễn Thị Thu, Head of Foreign Relations Department

3) Program Agreements. This MOU shall serve as the first agreement leading to any program agreements executed between the parties. It does not include information (i) that the Recipient already knew, (ii) that becomes public through no fault of the Recipient, (iii) that was independently developed by the Recipient or (iv) that was lawfully given to the Recipient by a third party.
- 9.2. The Recipient shall: (a) maintain all Confidential Information in strict and absolute confidence and refrain from any disclosure and/or publication and/or description and/or communication of Confidential Information, in whole or in part, to any third party whatsoever without the Discloser's written consent; (b) take all necessary precautions to keep Confidential Information secret and apply the same security measures and degree of care to Confidential Information as the Recipient applies to its own confidential information; and (c) inform the Discloser of any damage to or accidental loss of Confidential Information, including transfer to or use by unauthorized persons immediately.
- 9.3. The Recipient may disclose Confidential Information when required by law after giving reasonable notice to the Discloser, such notice to be sufficient to give the Discloser the opportunity to seek confidential treatment, a protective order or similar remedies or relief prior to disclosure.
- 9.4. If so requested by the Discloser at any time by written notice to the Recipient, the Recipient shall promptly: (a) destroy or return to the Discloser all documents and materials (and any copies thereof) containing, reflecting, incorporating or based on the Discloser's Confidential Information; (b) erase all Confidential Information from its own computer and communications systems, devices and other means of electronic storage; (c) erase all Confidential Information stored in electronic form in systems and data storage services owned by third parties; and (d) certify in writing to the Discloser that it has complied with the requirements of this clause.

10.2. This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon 30 (Thirty) days' written notice to the other Party.

## 11. GOVERNING LAW

11.1. This MoU shall be governed by the laws of India and the Parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Bengaluru, Karnataka, to resolve any dispute arising out of or in relation to this Agreement.
